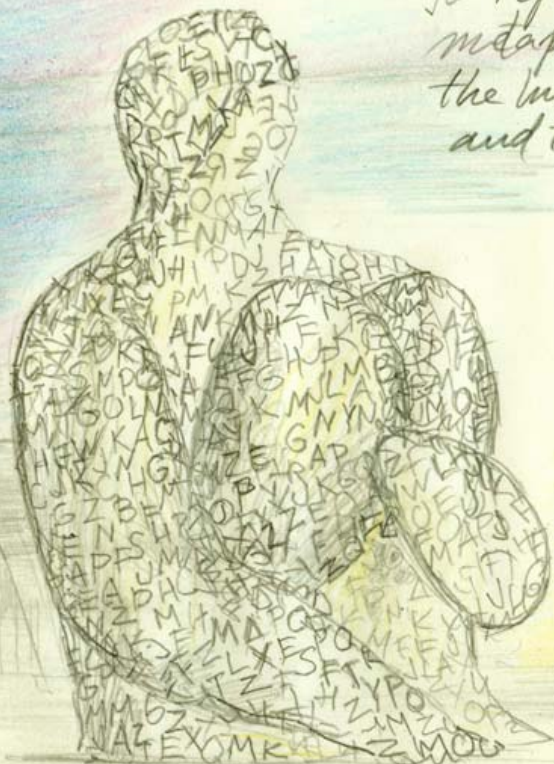

MONUMENT TO GOYA

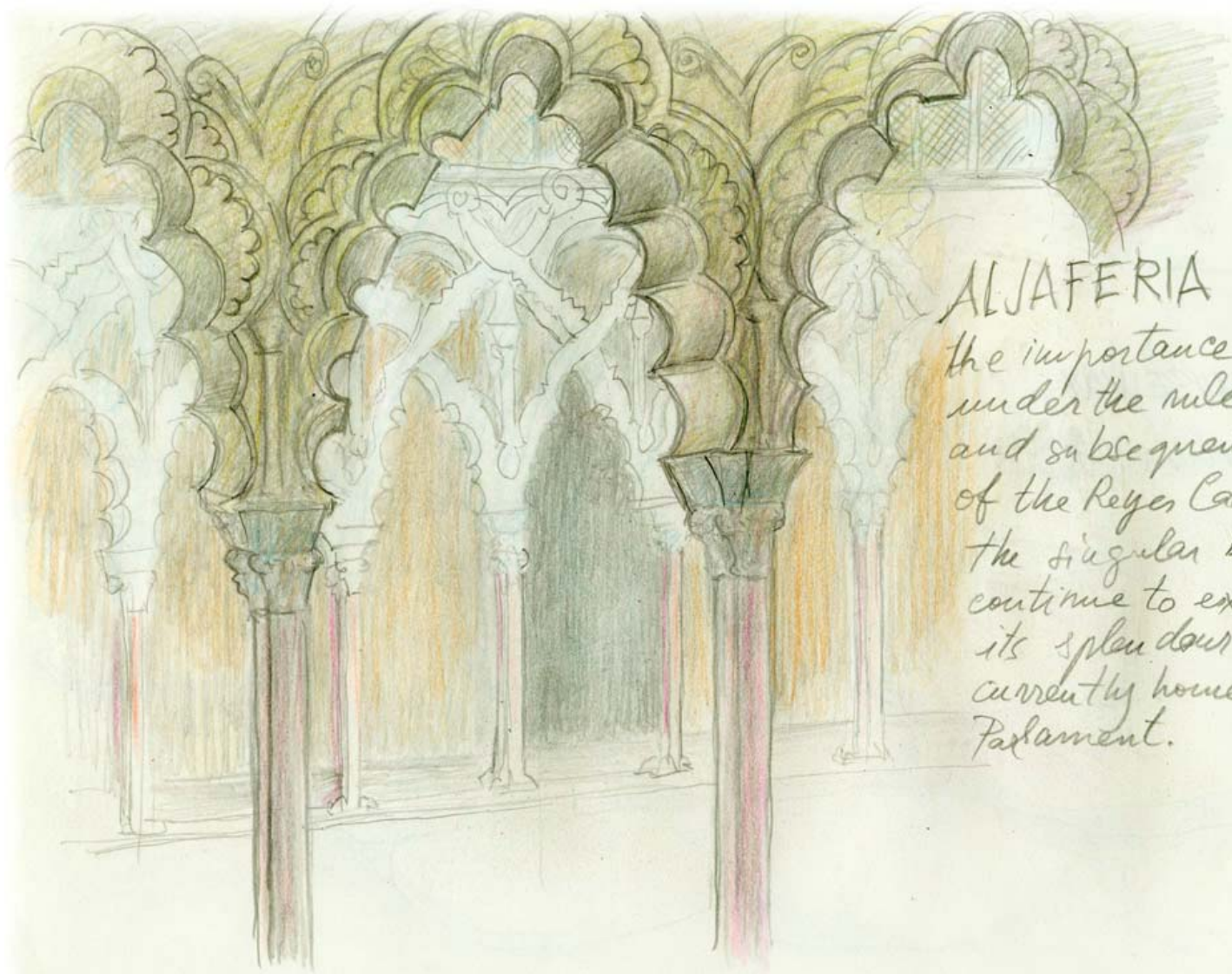
Goya was a court painter
