DISCOVER YOUR COMMUNITY: ARAGON

LOCATION

Aragon is geographically located in the north-east of Spain. It has an excellent strategic location due to its great accessibility to the principal ports and Spanish cities: Madrid, Barcelona, Bilbao and Valencia are in an approximate radius of 300 km from the centre of Aragon. Besides, it shares the north border with France.

The autonomous Community of Aragon has three provinces: Zaragoza, Huesca and Teruel. Every province is administratively divided in regions.

The <u>Autonomy Statute</u> of Aragon establishes in its First Title that they are institutions of the Autonomous Community of Aragon:

- The <u>Parliament of Aragon</u>: represents the Aragonese people and its principal functions are to elaborate the law regulations, to stimulate and to control Government acts and to approve the Budgets of the Autonomous Community.
- The President.
- The <u>General Deputation</u>: is integrated by the President and the Counsellors and exerts the executive function of the Autonomous Community.
- And the <u>Aragon justice</u>: Its mission is to protect and defend the collective or individual rights and freedoms, recognized by the Statute, the guardianship of the legal Aragonese classification, guarding over the defence and application, and the defence of the Statute.



In this way the institutional configuration of the Autonomous Community of Aragon attends the principles and needs of a modern society, incorporating simultaneously the sense of identity. The General Deputation of Aragon has the headquarters in the <u>Pignatelli Building</u>. The Spanish Parliament of Aragon resides in the Palace of the Aljafería. And the Aragon Justice is located in Armijo's Palace.

Spanish is the spoken language in Aragon. In some frontier areas with Catalonia Catalon is spoken as well and in some areas Aragonese dialect is spoken.

Nowadays, the main sectors in which people are employed at the Autonomous Community are: Automation, electrical and electronic material, chemical material, information technologies, machinery, paper, logistics and nutrition.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF ARAGON

The Kingdom of Aragon was born as a political body in the 11 th century, though on its lands numerous villages coexisted from the pre-Roman age. The Kings of Aragon governed for centuries the Wreath of Aragon. This was one of the most brilliant ages of our community.

The Kings of Aragon granted privileges to its village: the Aragonese people enjoyed their freedom and rights. Prove of it, though they changed over the time, we have the Aragonese Right and the Justice figure.

The history of Aragon, from its origins as a county in the 8 th century until these days has been marked by important facts for our land: <u>Compromiso de Caspe</u>, the expansion of the Aragonese Wreath of the Mediterranean, the <u>Mudejar</u> culture, the contribution to the <u>Spanish Illustration</u>, the <u>Independence War</u>, the <u>Spanish Civil war</u>, etc.

The wealth of the civil, political, artistic, scientific and philosophical life ... of Aragon during the history has provided illustrious representations of our culture, with great universal projection: The poet Marcial, the philosopher Avempace, the doctor and geographer Miguel Servet, the writer Gracián, the painter Goya, the Nobel Prized on Medicine Ramon and Cajal, the pianist Pilar Bayona, the authoress of famous "Dictionary of use of Spanish " Maria Moliner, the filmmaker Buñuel, international soprano Pilar Lorengar, the filmmakers Carlos and Antonio Saura, the sculptors Pablo Serrano and Pablo Gargallo, the writer Soledad Puértolas, or the tennis player Conchita Martínez ... and all the rest that you still have to discover!

The holidays celebrated by the Aragonese are:

- On April 23: San Jorge, patron of Aragon. It is the day of the Autonomous Community.
- On October 12: national Festivity. Holidays of the Pilar in Zaragoza, in honour to the Virgin of Pilar.

MULTICULTURAL ARAGON

In January, 2006 more than 75.000 foreigners were living in Aragon, mainly coming from the following continents Europe (42 %), Africa (25 %) and America (29 %). Zaragoza is an attractive city for the foreigners: In the Aragonese capital more than the half of the foreigners of Aragon live there.

Also the number of foreign population in Calatayud, Ricla, Cariñena and La Almunia is large where the number of the registered foreigners is over 15 %.







DISCOVER YOUR CITY: 7ARAGO7A

LOCATION

Zaragoza is the capital of the Autonomous Region of Aragon and the fifth largest city in Spain in terms of population size. It is geographically located in the north-east of Spain in the Ebro Valley and is well communicated with the main Spanish cities.

The city lies on the banks of the River Ebro and its tributaries Gállego and Huelva.

It has a continental climate, with cold winders and very hot summers. The "cierzo" (north wind) can sometimes blow with strong gusts, and the "bochorno" (hot wind) is dry but oppressive in the summer. The rainfall is low in the city and very irregular.

More than half of the working population is employed in the service sector. The industrial production activity is concentrated in industrial estates located on the outskirts of the city.

In the city centre you will find the principal monuments, cinemas, museums, theatres and shopping centres. The strong growth occurring in Zaragoza is giving rise to the creation of extensive residential areas which are attractive locations for large retail parks and leisure centres.

Zaragoza has been a University city for more than 500 years and has more than 50,000 higher education students. The faculties are largely concentrated in the campus of the Plaza de San Francisco and the recently created ACTUR technology park.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF ZARAGOZA

Zaragoza is known as the "city of the four cultures", due to the influence on its character of the four civilisations that occupied it. Founded by the low Iberians under the name of Salduie, it later became Roman (Caesaraugusta, in the confluence of the Rivers Ebro, Huerva and Gállego), then the Royal Arab capital (Saragusta) and the Christian capital of the Kingdom of Aragon.

During the War of Independence (1808-1814), Zaragoza resisted the siege of Napoleon's troops.

At the end of the 19th Century, it became a nucleus for rural immigrants who were attracted by the recent industrialisation process of the city and the arrival of the railway.





Zaragoza experienced rapid growth throughout the 20th Century. It outgrew its medieval walls and new districts were created as the population wished to reside close to their workplaces. Zaragoza also expanded on its left side; the vegetable and dry crops slowly disappeared, river areas railway areas were covered to create new streets...

The beginning of the 20th Century was characterised by significant transformations in the economic and social life of the city. New companies were established in the city (La Montañanesa, La Zaragozana...), together with a significant financial presence (Banco Zaragozano and Banco de Aragón).

From a social point of view, the incipient industrialisation process of the early decades of the 20th Century gave rise to the creation of a large labour movement, characterised by the implementation and expansion of trade unions and a constant generation of ideas and ideologies which were expressed in the many daily newspapers (Heraldo de Aragón, in 1895) and publications.

An economic boom began in the 1930s, which in Zaragoza was clearly visible in the growth in trade, banking and agro-food and metallurgical industries. Many public buildings were also constructed, including the University Campus which significantly modified the face of the city.

The period following the civil war (1936-1939) was characterised most of all by political repression and many years of shortages and economic precariousness. Zaragoza, however, during these post war years was still a nucleus for attracting mainly rural workers, who were seeking to improve their quality of life amidst the general crisis. In order to resolve the housing problems generated by this new population influx, in the 1950s, thousands of "viviendas protegidas" (subsidised housing) were built forming new districts.

The gradual improvement of the economic situation during the 1960s went hand in hand with building projects which were greatly significant for the city, such as the new City Council, between the Pilar Basilica and the Lonja, the renovation of the Paseo de la Independencia (Independence Promenade) or the construction of the Puente de Santiago (Santiago Bridge).

The last years of the Franco dictatorship (1970s and 1980s) were characterised by an intensification of the social and cultural life of the city, fundamentally directed at gaining political liberties. 1979 saw the first democratic elections in Spain since 1931. The achievements of this early democratic phase include the conditioning of spaces and buildings to be used by and serve the public. Also, current issues such as Independence and the fight for water, young rural emigration, immigration and the aging of the population which affect the whole region of Aragon, are more pronounced in Zaragoza.

In Zaragoza, the 21st Century has begun with a transformation and development process with respect to town planning, conditioned by two important events: the celebration of the bicentenario de los Sitios (bicentenary commemoration of the siege of Zaragoza) of 1808-1809 and the <u>International Exhibition 2008</u> (From 14th June to 14th September 2008), which will have the theme of "water and sustainable development."

The city is at a critical moment, with the initiation of development projects which aim to consolidate the role of Zaragoza as a great city on a regional, national and international scale.





The people of Zaragoza enjoy the following festivals during the year:

- 29th January: San Valero. Patron Saint of the City of Zaragoza. No one goes without the traditional "roscón" (ring cake).
- 5th March: Cincomarzada. To celebrate the expulsion of the Carlist troops by the people of Zaragoza in 1838.
- 23rd April: San Jorge (Saint George), patron saint of Aragon. This festival is celebrated by the whole Region.
- 12th October: Fiestas del Pilar. Fiestas del Pilar in Zaragoza, in honour of the Saint Pilar.

MULTICULTURAL ZARAGOZA

Due to its location, Zaragoza has had the opportunity of being the meeting point of a large variety of cultures. As an open city, its history has been marked by the contributions of the different civilisations that settled on these lands.

Throughout the 20th Century, the population of Zaragoza grew with the arrival of citizens from every part of Aragon and other regions of Spain.

The Zaragoza of the 21st Century is a multicultural city, due to its capacity to welcome a growing foreign population: 11% of its population is made up of inhabitants from abroad. This population group, which is mainly young, gives a breath of fresh air to the aging population with a decreasing fertility rate.

In 2006, the foreign residents in the city of Zaragoza represented 75,000 people. 47% of them are women and 53% men with an average age of 30. There are people living in Zaragoza who come from 130 different countries. The main region of origin is Central and South America. However, the two most representative countries of origin are Rumania and Ecuador.

The city of Zaragoza is twinned with other cities of the world.

PRINCIPAL MUNICIPAL BODIES

After the local elections of 1979, the first democratic governments were installed in the City Councils. Currently, the municipalities have a high degree of independence and improved management capacity, which has given rise to a significant presence of the municipal institutions in the social, cultural and political life of the city.

The City Council of Zaragoza is divided into areas:

- Presidency and Social Actions.
- Town Planning, Housing, Architecture and Environment.
- Devlopment and Sports.
- Public Services.
- Infrastructures and Citizen Involvement.
- Inland Revenue, Economy and Interior Regulations.
- Culture and Education.

Some procedures may be carried out by the municipal, district and neighbourhood councils, as municipal management is decentralised.

Principal authorities

The local councils have the power to make regulations, that is the power to develop, within the area of their competence, that which is set forth in the state or regional laws. As a consequence of this power, the local councils may pass general bye laws to regulate life in the city.

The power to make regulations of the local councils is materialised through bye laws and regulations approved by the city council meeting. Bye laws refer to the municipal regulations that affect citizens and regulations refer to internal rules of self-government.

You will find the reglamento organico municipal (municipal ground rules) and the normativa municipal (city regulated material) classified by subject matter on the website of the City Council of Zaragoza.

Ayuntamiento en Casa (City Council at home)

The Ayuntamiento en Casa (City Council at Home) service will help you to process your most frequent procedures with the council offices. You can carry out certain procedures from home without having to go to the Council Offices in person.

You can search for the service that you are interested in by subject matter or by carrying out a direct search, entering the name of the matter that you wish to process (eg: "census", "wedding") in the "Procedures Guide" form. Once you have access to the results, confirm how the procedures can be carried out in person, by Internet, by phone or by post.

Guidance on residence and work permit procedures.

CENSUS (REGISTRATION AT THE CITY COUNCIL)

This register is the record of your place of living and the home address of the neighbours in a certain town upon all administrative effects, regardless of your nationality or if you have a the respective resident's permit or not. Those who live in more than one town will register at the place where they spend more time.

- The information provided is confidential.
- The registration provides the right to get social protection programmes such as education, labour help, housing, etc.
- The registration at the census register also gives you the right to receive sanitary assistance, in which the foreigner can ask for his sanitary card and to get the same help provided to Spanish citizens.

As soon as you have a permanent residence you have to go to your City Council or to the <u>municipal Committee</u> or <u>neighbourhood committee</u> and ask for the application form either the collective (for all the family members) or the individual ones. To know which Committee you belong to look it up at the Committee map of the City Council.





You have to submit the following documentation:

- Official identification document of the person who requests the census: If you are Spanish, your I.D., passport or driver's licence, if you are from a European Community member state, a certificate accrediting you are registered in the foreign citizens' register, your passport or the I.D. of your country of origin, if you are a foreign citizen, your resident's permit or passport.
- The document that proves your place of residence: house purchase title deeds, rent contract which dates back over 5 years, or the last bill (water, gas, electricity, etc.) The name and the address have to be clear. These documents have to be original.
- In case that your place of residence is not your property but you wish to use it as your residence address, you will need an authorization signed by the owner and a photocopy of his ID card DNI, passport or any other personal identification.
- Children passports and family book both in originals and photocopies.

It is important that you keep the following things in mind:

- Your registration at the Municipal register Census only takes effect the time endured the fact that motivated it (residence time).
- Any way, it will be necessary to renew your registration every two years specially for non EU residents without permanent residence in Spain.
- In case of renewals you have to go to the municipal offices before the expiry date. Otherwise it will be automatically discharged.
- The documents that prove your identity has to be valid at that time.

 - National Security affiliation number (it is requested at the National Security Treasury Office the one you belong to in your neighbourhood) [See the treasury addresses in EMPLOYMENT / SOCIAL SECURITY]
- Your personal sanitary (health) card will be issued it proves that you are now a user of the National Health System.
- You will be allocated a **family doctor**; he will be the professional who will assist you whenever you ask for an appointment at your health centre.
- The sanitary card enables you to the buy medication of the National Security Health Service (normally is cheaper).

DRIVING LICENCE

If you come to visit Spain as a tourist and want to rent a car check that your driving licence is valid here. Driver's licenses issued by a European Community member state under the community legislation are valid in Spain, with the exception that the age for driving age is the same age for obtaining the equivalent

Spanish driver's licence.

If you live in Spain you can use your home country driving licence during the first six months starting from the moment you are given your residence authorization.

When you are past the deadline, you will have start the procedures to get the equivalent Spanish driving licence unless you belong to one of the countries that have an agreement with Spain.

You can use the <u>scheduled appointment system</u>, by Internet, only if you have a driving licence from Argentina, Bulgaria, Colombia, Ecuador, Morocco, Peru, Uruguay, Chile, Romania Venezuela and Algeria, and when you are added to the system- Drivers' and Vehicles Record of the Traffic Headquarter-, for owning a vehicle, driving license or had been a candidate previously.

If you want to send mail, you can do it at the **Post office and Telegraphs offices** in your neighbourhood. The head office is in the centre: Paseo Independencia, 33 - Tel. 976 23 68 68. Timetable from 8:30 a.m till 8:30 p.m, Monday to Friday and Saturdays from 9 a.m till 2 p.m. There are telephone booth services and abroad money sending too.

Also you can send money through the accredited booths or bank companies (Banks).

MICROCREDITS

A microcredit is a small loan that is granted to people with special social labour situation, limited income, cannot get a traditional loans hence lacking guarantees or collaterals.

The microcredits are granted especially for:

- To satisfy basic needs (housing, furniture purchase, family regrouping trips, driving licence, sanitary assistance, etc).
- Self employment Initiatives and micro companies creation.

The bank companies, CAI, IBERCAJA or the CAIXA, in collaboration with social and managerial Aragonese organizations, manage this type of loans.







HOUSING

The housing market in the city of Zaragoza both for hiring and buying is difficult. Apart from contacting with the companies mentioned here, it is important that you also look by yourself in the free housing market such as (street advertisements, newspapers, etc.). You can also come to real state agencies, although they charge for their services. Pay attention to certain services that are offered like lists of housing, which require a payment but they don't guarantee finding a house.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The sanitary assistance is a UNIVERSAL RIGHT.

Spain has a public and free sanitary system; all who are in its territory have the right to get these services. The type of help will depend on your situation:

- If you live illegally and are not registered [See CENSUS / BASIC RESOURCES RECORD] at your place of residence, you have right to the sanitary assistance only in case of an emergency. In case of a sanitary emergency you will receive attention at a health centre of [See HEALTH CENTRES related to this topic]. If you get there, call the emergency phone number 061 or 112. This assistance will cover:
 - o Critical illnesses care
 - Serious Accidents
- If you are registered at the City Hall, whatever legal situation is (with residence permit) or ilegal [See CENSUS RECORD / BASIC RESOURCES], in both cases you have right to the sanitary care service like Spanish people.
- This assistance will cover:
 - Critical illnesses Attention
 - Serious Accidents
 - o Primary care and specialists
 - Pregnancies Attention, childbirths and postpartum
- If you are younger than eighteen you are entitled to receive sanitary assistance like Spanish people.
- If you are pregnant you are entitled to receive sanitary assistance during the pregnancy, childbirth and postpartum.

Emergency Room E.R.

Before going to E.R., think if your problem might be solved in another way (primary assistance, previous consultation appointment, etc.). The E.R. responsibility is to assist serious cases. The use of the E.R services is to solve banal or non-urgent problems reduces the available resources to assist patients who need **urgent or vital assistance**.

If this is your situation you can call the following telephone number the 24 hours of the day during the whole year **SOS ARAGON 112** where you will receive an immediate police protection and your entry to a 24 hour Emergency Centre will be managed, depending on the gravity of the situation, there you will receive free accommodation, social and psychological help for both your under-aged children and yourself.

The Aragonese Women Institute puts at your disposition the **24 hour Telephone - 900 504 405.** It offers information, legal advice and social care to women victims of violence. Face to face and professional care activates are activated if necessary, which belong to the Permanent Legal Services Assistance and / or the Social Care of the Social Attendees of the Police office.

These three telephones are free and work the 24 hours a day, all the days of the year and you can access them from any point of the Aragonese territory.

Compulsory and post obligatory education

The education of kids aged between 6 to 16 years is **obligatory and free** in Spain.

There are two types of educational centres:

- The **public** ones that depend on the Aragonese Public Administration and that are managed by the Education Department of the Government of Aragon. These centres are free.
- The **compound** ones that depend on religious institutions or private organisations. The Education Department of the Government of Aragon has established concerts of collaboration with them.

Also we can define them according to the educational cycle:

- Children and primary Education students aged from 3 to 12 years attend this school.
- Secondary Obligatory Education (IT) students aged from 12 to 16.
- None obligatory secondary Education: Baccalaureate and Vocational training.

The **Baccalaureate** is the last stage of the Secondary Education, non-obligatory and the duration is two courses, normally between 16 and 18 years.

It has different modalities that allow a specialized preparation to get to the superior stages or join the working force.

The **Vocational training** (**Middle Degree** or **High Degree**), non- obligatory, includes a set of education, within the educational system, they qualify the student to practice different types of professions. The duration of every cycle is changeable.

The students who overcome the Vocational training education of middle degree and high degree obtain, respectively the Technician or high Technician degree. With the Technician's degree it is possible to get to Baccalaureate. With the high Technician degree you can access directly, without an entry test, to certain University Education related to the studies of Vocational training you have, which are determined by the corresponding regulation.

The <u>Popular University</u> is a municipal service of education for adults older than 16 years. Offers the citizens the possibility of completing, updating and enriching their training to take part in a dynamical and changeable society.

The course and activity programmes are prepared in a decentralized way in the different neighbourhoods (civic centres) of the city.

The Popular University carries out <u>annual training actions</u>, each four months and each six months in the following areas:

 Basic Education: basic training (reading and writing, maths, Social – natural knowledge, etc.) at the city neighbourhoods, starting from the reality of each one and attending its necessity.







- Personal Development: programs oriented to achieving a major enjoyment of the leisure and free time, encouroging the creativity through plastic arts, artistic and literary communication, and the knowledge of the history of Aragon and of Zaragoza
- Occupational Training: training that facilitates the access of the adult persons to the new technologies and to the society of the information. Also we facilitate <u>Spanish for immigrants</u> and French and English.
- Social Participation: Introductory Psychological programmes, personal relations, health and the social environment developed through chats, seminars and training courses. It's worth mentioning the Fathers and Mothers Training Programme named <u>Ciudadan@s para el siglo XXI</u>, it's objective is to support the Mother's and Fathers Association's work (AMPAS).

If you are Father or Mother, find out also on the Program of training of Parents and Mothers.

The courses that belong to the "Spanish Program for Foreigners" are free. Also there are free those of the "Program of Basic Education".

The Popular University organizes <u>complementary activities</u> like chats, gatherings, visits to exhibitions, trips and crossed by places of artistic or cultural interest, contests of painting and exhibitions of groups arisen in the workshops of the popular University.

EMPLOYMENT

SOCIAL SECURITY

The International Organization of Work defines the Social Security as: "The protection that the society provides to its members, by means of a series of public measurements, against the economic and social privations which, of not being like that, would cause the disappearance or a strong reduction of the income because of disease, maternity, accident of work, or occupational disease, unemployment, invalids, oldness and death; and also the protection in the shape of medical assistance and help to the families with children.

Inside the Spanish system of Social Security two groups of rate are distinguished: General Regime and Special Rate:

- The **General Regulation** is the most wide and in it the workers are included by foreign account.
- Inside the **Special Rate** there are included professional special activities: workers for own account or autonomous, agrarian workers, workers of the sea, servants, etc.

¿How does it work?

• If you work for foreign account (opposite of "autonomous " or " own account "), your company will give you of discharge in the Social Security before initiating the labour relation. If it is the first time that you are employed with contract at Spain, you will be assigned a **Social Security affiliation number** (it is the same number that appears on your sanitary card).

The businessman and the worker are forced to pay the corresponding share of the General Regulation of the Social Security. The businessman pays a monthly fee for every worker. The worker on the other hand is discounted an amount of money from his salary. This money contributed to the Social Security serves in order that the worker could benefit from a series of provisions: sanitary assistance, unemployment benefit, subsidy of temporary disability, pharmaceutical helps, etc.

The company will quote since the worker begins to work (included the period of test) and the quote extending during the period of contracting.

If you need to consult your labour situation go to the Treasury office of the Social Security (between 9 a.m. and 11 a.m.) and with your DNI/ NIE ask for your **Labour's Report**. In this report your discharges and falls remain reflected to the Social Security and the days quoted by your work in the different companies.

Also you can call **901 50 20 50** (an automatic answerer will sound; you choose the second option " **Labour's Report** ", marking the 1 in your telephone). The report you will be sent by ordinarily post to the resident where you are registered. If your place of current residence is different, you will have to come to the Treasuries.

In the <u>web page of the Social Security</u> you will find information about the set of services that they offers. You can choose the language among Spanish, English and French.

• If you are autonomous or have to quote in one of the <u>Special Regulation</u> mentioned previously you will find all the necessary information in the web page of the Social Security.

PUBLIC FINANCE

The Public Finance is the organization that manages the collection of the taxes in Spain.

Every year, people who live in Spain have to make the **income statement**. The IRPF (Personal Income tax) burdens the obtaining revenue for the persons who during the year had, with general character, your habitual residence in Spain, taking in consideration your personal and familiar circumstances. The collected funds will serve to the maintenance of the schools, hospitals, public works, etc.





In your payroll, a percentage of your salary will be dedicated to the payment of the IRPF. This amount depends on what you win a year and of your personal situation; normally it varies between 2 % and 16 %.

In March, you will be able to request a draft of your declaration. The State will verify then that the full percentage corresponds to your personal situation. In case there is an imbalance, you will have to pay taxes or a part will be returned to you.

The maximum term to present the income statement usually ends in June.

The Number of fiscal identification (NIF) is the system of tax identification used in Spain for the persons (with national document of identity DNI, or number of foreigner's identification NIE, assigned by the Ministry of the Interior).

If you have any doubt, you can consult in the Offices of Information of your Delegation or Administration, or call on the telephone 901 33 55 33 in schedule from Monday to Friday from 9 to 19 hours. (From 9 to 21 hours and Saturdays from 9 to 14 hours. during May and June).

Protected employment

The protected employment receives the workers who cannot manage or support an employment in the conventional way. It aims to provide a contract of work in an ordinary way or in a protected way.

Social -labour Centres (CSL)

The Social -labour Centres aims to promote the social and labour integration of the most young unemployed, by means of actions of formation and insertion. From 16 to 25 are directed 15-year-old young people derivative by school orientation and young people without school qualifications or professional qualification.

Look for the most nearby local CSL where you live.

Youth Insertion Plan of Aragon (Plan FIJA)

Combines formation and employment and is directed for young people between 16 and 20 years.

It facilitates the contact to you with a company with which you start working as apprentice (you don't need experience nor previous formation), with a <u>contract for the formation</u> of a minimal duration of 6 months, extendable up to 2 years.

Your salary corresponds to 80 % of the salary stipulated in the collective agreement, since it is the percentage of time of effective work that you are going to make in the company. The other 20 % corresponds to formation and receives an economic aid.

This type of contract allows you to accede to the labour world and to be formed in a trade, possessing the support of a personal tutor.

Workshop Schools (ET), Profession Houses and Employment Workshops

These projects are promoted by public and non – profit organizatios with the collaboration of the INAEM. Ther Workshop Schools (ET) and Profession Houses are work and training centers where unemployed young people get professional training alternating theory with practice so that they can dominate a profession and their access to the work world is easier.

The Workshop Schools (from 1 to 2 years) and Profession Houses(1 year) cosisit of two stages:

- In the first one, students receive professional training both theoraticall and practical and the necessary knowledge to prevent the work risks at their work place. During this period they receive an economical subsidy as a training scholarship.
- In the second one the employed students subscribe to a working contract for this training in a promoting organization, for which they receive 75% of the minimum professional salary valid for that year. During this time they'll be doing works of useful use to the public and the society and will continue with their training process started at the first part.

Requirements: to be older than 16 years and younger than 25, to be unemployed and to be looking for employment inscribed in the public services of employment (INAEM).

POPULAR UNIVERSITY

The Popular University is a municipal service of education for adults, people older than 16. It offers the citizens the possibility of completing, updating and enriching their training to take part in a dynamical and changeable society.

Provides attention to groups with educational and cultural needs such as women, unemployed people, immigrants and old people, throughout specific actions.

The course and activities programmes are developed in a decentralized way in the different neighbourhoods (civic centres) of the city.

The <u>Popular University</u> of Zaragoza, throughout the courses, workshops, and cultural activities, proposes training for the citizens participation in the daily environment.

The Popular University carries out <u>training actions</u> annually, each four months and half-yearly in the following areas:

- Basic Education: basic training (reading and writing, maths, knowledge about the natural surroundings, etc.) in the city neighbourhoods, to start with the of each one's reality and attending their needs.
- Personal Development: programs directed to achieving a major enjoyment of leisure and free time, encouraging the creation through the plastic arts, the artistic and literary communication, and the knowledge of the history of Aragon and of Zaragoza.
- Occupational Training: to provide the adult access to the new technologies and to the information of the society. Also we provide <u>Spanish language teaching for immigrants</u> as well as French and English.





Social Participation: Introductory Psychological programmes, personal relations, health and the social environment developed through chats, seminars and training courses. It's worth mentioning the Fathers and Mothers Training Programme named <u>Ciudadan@s para el siglo XXI</u>, it's objective is to support the Mother's and Fathers Association's work (AMPAS).

The courses that belong to the "Spanish Program for Foreigners" are free. Also the "Program of Basic Education "are also free.

The Popular University organizes <u>complementary activities</u> like chats, gatherings, exhibitions visits, trips to places of artistic or cultural interest, painting contests and group exhibitions that arise in the workshops of the popular University.

You have to register to access these courses and workshops.

Bonuses exist for large families, unemployed, retired (or pensioners) and for people with low income (circumstances that must be proved by a photocopy of the corresponding document).

MULTICULTURAL PROGRAMME

- Associations, social organizations and other groups
- Children and teenagers
- The population in general

ASOCIACIONISM: "ASSOCIATIONS' HOTEL"

The so called "Associations' hotel" is the Support Service provided to the Foreigners' Associations by the City Council of Zaragoza. It's principal aim is to be used as a headquarter for the foreigners' associations.

It is composed by the foreigners' associations and ethnic minorities that assemble the requirements that are listed below:

- To be legally constituted.
- To form part of the General Meeting Committee of the House of Cultures.
- To be a non-profit organization.
- To be registered at the municipal census of civil entities.
- That their aims are identical to the aim of the House of Cultures.

The foreigners' associations have the possibility to form a part of the General Meeting Committee of the House of Cultures, and thus take part in the decision making of the House.

The Associations Hotel will have a reserved space for the internal activities of it's members and, as other groups, they will be able to have, the common spaces of the building as well.

In the House of Cultures you will find also the following services:

- Support with the creation of associations and with the search of subsidies.
- Advising for immigrants' associations.
- Offers of specific courses on the management of associations.

ENGLISH CLASSES FOR IMMIGRANTS

There are basic Spanish courses medium and deepening as well.

They take place during the summer: July, August and September. There are groups of adults and teenagers in the morning and evening schedules.

Enrolment: the second fortnight of June. Free.

REFURBISHMENT OF HOUSES COURSE

Labour insertion for Immigrants and Gypsies: the aim of this programme is to integrate, socially and labour, the groups of immigrants and ethnic minorities through the training in the profession of building and to refurbish municipal buildings or houses.

- Course Organization: 25 % of building training in a workshop (learning the basic technologies of building) + 70 % of training done in a real work place + 5 % of basic training (Mathematics, Language, social culture and Labour training).
- Approximate Duration: a natural year. Basic training: two months. Building training in a workshop: two months. Training in a real work place: the rest of the course.







SOCIAL INSERTION REPORT BY ROOTING

Issuing the report is to request the residence authorization by rooting reasons of the foreign worker who proves his continued stay in Spain during a minimal period of three years.

Requirements:

To lack penal precedents in Spain and in the country of origin
 Not to have the prohibition to enter Spain
 To possess a work contract

■ To prove having familiar links with other foreign residents, or to submit a report that proves social insertion expressed by the City Council in the one where it's your habitual residence

REPORTS ON HOUSING AVAILABILITY FOR FAMILY REGROUPING

Issuing the appropriate report of housing availability to be incorporate into the temporary residence authorization application for non community foreigners, in favour of the members of the family that wants to be regrouped.

SOCIAL – EDUCATIONAL INVOLVEMENT IN GYPSY FAMILIES

It's purpose is to consolidate under a stable character the normalization and social integration processes of the gypsy families in the situation of social risk.

That's why we rely on two social workers and two gypsy mediators. In collaboration with the Association of Gypsy Promotion of Zaragoza.

IMMIGRANTS' VOLUNTARY RETURN (PREVIE)

This program is an initiative of the International Organization of the Migrations (OIM) that offers information and advising on the return to the countries of origin, offers help in the processing of the necessary documentation for the return, trip bills, possibility of economic aid for the reimbursement in the country and return follow-ups.

For extra community immigrants, in social vulnerability condition, with serious problems of integration and extreme poverty, victims of the traffic of human beings and that want to return to their home country.

INTERPRETERS' SERVICES

Permanent service of Interpreters that complements the labour of the Services of the House the Cultures and of the Bar association of Zaragoza. It guarantees the assistance with an interpreter with the foreigners who do not know our language and lack economic resources.

The application form will be done throughout the professionals that need it, being in touch with the House of Cultures for the intervention in social matters, or with the Bar association to interfere in legal or police Institutions.







The area of performance of the Service is the city of Zaragoza. The service guarantees the support in the administrative, legal, sanitary dependence ... in whatever it's needed.
