Students, professionals, activists of civil society aged between 20 and 35 from Euro-Med region.



The proposals included A Euro-Med Roadmap of Water, a proposal for the application of non-conventional stormwater management techniques in urban areas, suggestions for utilising rainwater sources in schools for the reduction of tap water consumption.
