MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS MAY 2023

On May the 28th, 2023, municipal elections will be held, in which the people who will form the Town Halls for the next four years will be elected.

If you are over 18 years of age, your vote is essential because the people who will come out of the polls will represent you in your municipality and whose decisions will affect the well-being and quality of life of the citizens. Its policies will determine, among others, the development of the social services area and will be decisive in issues such as employment, equality, integration in terms of immigration or cooperation development.

To exercise your right, whether you are a citizen of a European Union country or from a non-EU country with an agreement, you must register in the **ELECTORAL CENSUS OF FOREIGN RESIDENTS (CERE)**

Citizens of THE EUROPEAN UNION COUNTRIES (including Switzerland and Liechtenstein)

If you have already exercised your right to vote previously, you do not have to do anything since you are already on the electoral roll. Around the time of the elections, you will receive a card from the Electoral Census Office in which you will be informed of the polling station where you can vote.

If you have never voted and want to do so, it is essential that you register on the electoral roll **before January the 30th, 2023**, for which it is required:

- Registration in your city census
- Express the will to exercise the right to vote in municipal elections. This requirement can be achieved through several ways:
 - **If you have received a letter from the Statistics National Institute (INE)** with the CERE-DFA form and a CTT code, you can fill in the form and send it by postal mail to the address indicated. Or you can fill out the CERE-DFA form online entering the INE Electronic Office at <https://sede.ine.gob.es> (Procedures – Electoral Census), accessing with Cl@ve or with the CTT code enclosed in your letter.
 - **If you have not received the letter from the INE** you can apply for the CERE-DFA form at the Zaragoza City Council Municipal and Neighborhood Board or download it from the City Council website (<https://www.zaragoza.es/sede/servicio/tramite/31744>). Once completed, you must send it by postal mail or through the Registry department of the Zaragoza's Provincial Delegation of the National Institute of Statistics located in calle Albareda, number 18, 50004 Zaragoza.

Or you can also carry out this procedure through the INE Electronic Office at <https://sede.ine.gob.es> (Procedures – Electoral Census), for which it is required to prove identity through the Cl@ve system

Citizens of NON-EU COUNTRIES WITH AGREEMENT (Bolivia, Cape Verde, Chile, Colombia, Korea, Ecuador, Iceland, Norway, New Zealand, Paraguay, Peru, United Kingdom, Trinidad and Tobago)

If you are a citizen of one of these countries, in order to exercise your right to vote you must express your intention to vote in each electoral process, so the census of previous processes is not longer kept.

Therefore, it is essential that you register in the census within **December the 1th 2022 and January the 15th. 2023** for which you need:

- Registration in your city census.
- Be in possession of a legal residence permit in Spain.
- Have legally resided in Spain for 5 years (3 years in the case of Norway and the United Kingdom).

If you meet all these requirements, you will be able to express your intention to vote through several ways:

- **If you have received a letter from the National Institute of Statistics (INE)** with the CERE-N form and a CTT key, you can fill in the form and send it by post to the indicated address. Or you can fill the form online by entering the INE Electronic Office at <https://sede.ine.gob.es> (Procedures – Electoral Census), accessing with Cl@ve or with the CTT code enclosed in your letter.
- **If you have not received the letter from the INE**, you can apply for the CERE-N form at the Zaragoza City Council Municipal and Neighborhood Boards or download it from the website (<https://www.zaragoza.es/sede/servicio/tramite/31744>). Once completed, you must send it by postal mail or through the Registry department of the Zaragoza's Provincial Delegation of the National Institute of Statistics located in calle Albareda, number 18, 50004 Zaragoza.
